

NOTE CHOIR HISTORY

The Note Choir of Sinai, formally known as Choir No. II was established by the late Reverend T. F. Fraylon in 1942. While under the leadership of Pastor Emeritus, George Cook, Jr. he renamed Choir No. II to The Note Choir of Sinai. Shape note music was designed for a novice to learn how to read sight music.

To continue the legacy of the Note Choir, Deacon Stradford passed on the baton to the late Brother Darryl Peters who served as Chorister until 2018. Presently Sister Mary Covington holds the baton passed down from Brother Peters as Chorister and with the assistance of Sister Dorothy Lipscomb.

The Note Choir of Sinai has upheld their commitment to serve the community by working with various organizations in the Charlotte area. They work closely with Charlotte Emergency Housing assisting with keeping families together and establishing permanent housing. The choir members faithfully enjoy visiting the nursing homes, singing uplifting songs to the residents; in addition to serving seniors and the sick and shut-in within the church and community.

In 2001, The Note Choir of Sinai joined the United Vocal Choir Convention, Sister Mary Covington was the liaison in building this connection. As part of the United Vocal Convention, the Note Choir has established relationships with choirs throughout Charlotte and surrounding areas.

Presently, under the leadership of Reverend Dr. Major A. Stewart, we're continuing to rehearse every other Friday of each month.

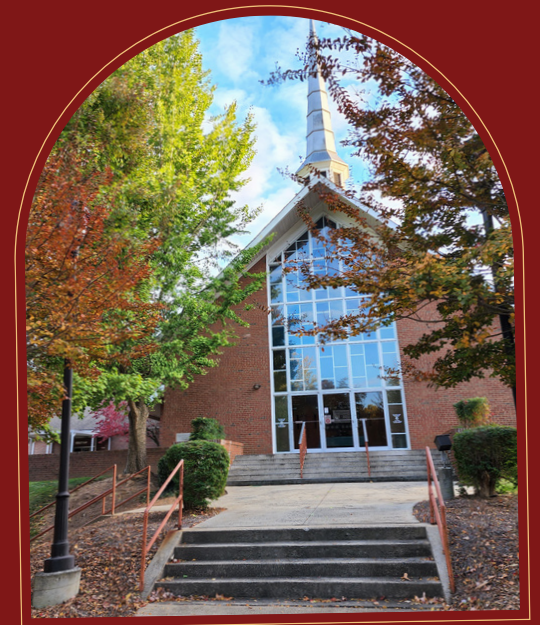

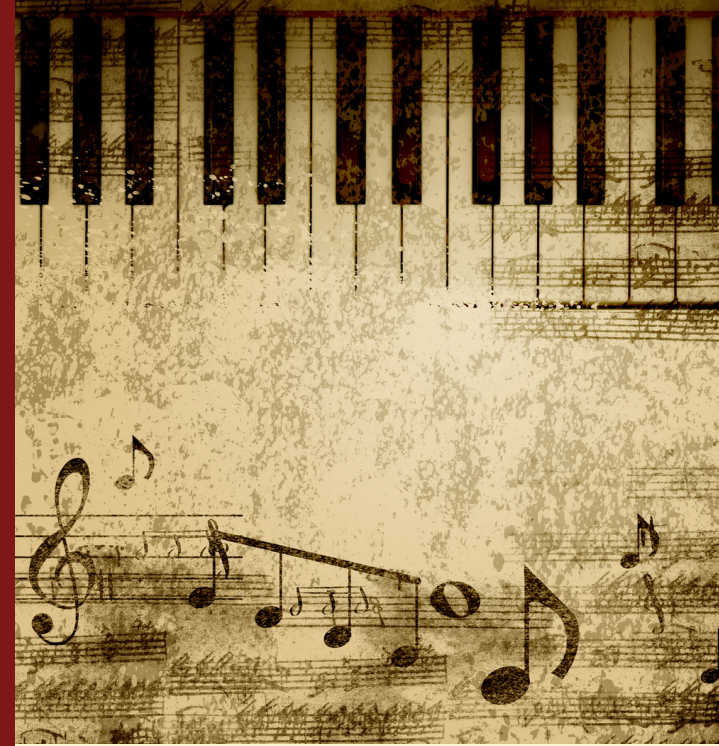
